Thank you for your request for information which the GLA received on 27 December 2017. Your request has been dealt with under the Freedom of Information Act 2000.

This includes all of the tables in the database. To make it easier to access the non-residential data you have requested, the *Planning permissions on the London Development Database* page on the London Datastore has now been updated with new files breaking down the non-residential floorspace and bedrooms data from the London Development Database;

The data used to produce the completions and housing pipeline data in London Plan AMR 13 can be found at;

The LDD allows for permissions to supersede some or all of the units in another permission. Once a unit is superseded or completed, it is removed from the pipeline. In the case of Barking Riverside, a total of 10,043 units were included in the pipeline figure. Note that there is a single start date for a scheme. This does not imply that all of the units are physically under construction, it means the start on site means the permission cannot lapse. For more information see paragraphs 3.41 and 3.46 of the [AMR 13](#).
