Freedom of Information Act request

Thank you for your request for information which the GLA received on **27 January 2016**. Your request has been dealt with under the Freedom of Information Act 2000 and we can today provide you with a response to your request. Your request asked for the release of the following information:

1. *Please can you inform me what information (including data) was supplied to you by London Borough of Southwark for the London Land Commission Register and <https://maps.london.gov.uk/webmaps/LLC/>?*
2. *Please can you inform me what locations contained within the London Land Commission Register and / or shown on <https://maps.london.gov.uk/webmaps/LLC/> are "capacity" to create new homes?*

Our response to your request is as follows:

By way of clarification, the information held within the London Land Commission Register collates and records only land and property in public ownership. The property information for the London Borough of Southwark is available on the Council's website.

The GLA will separately work with all public landowners to identify sites suitable for residential use in London and assess the related housing capacity. The information shown on <https://maps.london.gov.uk/webmaps/LLC/> represents only data on property ownership.
