How many complimentary tickets have been given to LGA staff to attend West Ham United matches in 2017?

Can you provide a breakdown please of, a) the name of the member of staff, b) details of the West Ham fixture attended, and c) Any other hospitality they enjoyed at the match such as lunch or drinks including the value?

Please find attached the information we hold within the scope of your request.

The GLA keeps a register of gifts and hospitality with a value of £25 or more, based on records submitted by staff and Members in line with guidance, which is published $\frac{\text{here}}{\text{here}}$ – see the section Code of conduct on the receipt of gifts and hospitality.

- 1 All hospitality accepted by elected Members or Senior staff appears on the hospitality register which is published at https://www.london.gov.uk/about-us/governance-and-spending/good-governance/gifts-and-hospitality. The list can be filtered by Donor/Provider to find the instances where hospitality was provided by West Ham United.
 - The published version does not show 'values', so please see the attached file which contains extracted information complete with the values as submitted. I should stress that these values are *estimated* by the person who received the hospitality or gift.
- We do not publish details of gifts and hospitality for other GLA staff on this page. However, we conducted a separate search of all gifts and hospitality declared by staff. And there were no records with the scope of your request.
