Thank you for your request for information which the Greater London Authority (GLA) received on 25 July 2017. Your request has been dealt with under the Freedom of Information Act 2000.

You requested:

"Please provide details of all expenses claimed and paid to Amy Lane the night czar since she was appointed.

Please include copies of receipts for every claim."

Please find the relevant information attached. We have made some redactions to withhold junior staff names and part of a credit card number from the disclosed information as they constitute third-party personal data which is exempt from release under the provision of section 40(2) of the FoI Act. This provides that personal data (as defined under the Data Protection Act 1998) can be withheld from disclosure in to the public domain where that disclosure would be contrary to one of the Data Protection Principles under that Act. In this case, disclosure would be in breach of the first principle and constitute unfair processing of that data.
