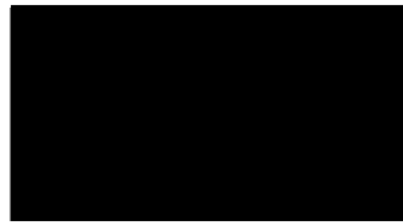

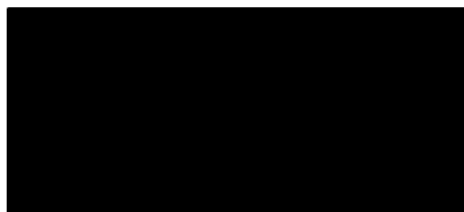
Dear Sian,
