The Mayor of London, Sadiq Khan, will mark the launch of the £10-a-day Toxicity Charge (T-Charge) in central London to drive down harmful emissions and help clean-up London's filthy air.

From Monday motorists will start paying the T-Charge, the toughest vehicle emissions standard of any world city, affecting the oldest and most polluting vehicles. It will operate additionally to, and during the same operating times, as the Congestion Charge, making the full charge £21.50.

Sadiq will join children planting a garden at the UCL Day Nursery in Bloomsbury, which is based near a busy road in the T-Charge zone. The nursery also has a specific room it uses as a refuge for children on high pollution days.
