Thank you for your request for information which the Greater London Authority (GLA) received on 22 May 2020. Your request has been considered under the Freedom of Information Act 2000.

You requested:

I wish to request information regarding Peabody Housing Association. Have the UK Government provided Peabody with a grant or any form of extra funding during the 2019-2020 Covid-19 outbreak? If so, how much and for what purpose were they given this money?

Our response to your request is as follows:

I note that your request refers to “the UK Government”. The GLA is London's strategic government and does not operate in the same way as the national Government and we can only respond about information that is held by the GLA.

I can confirm that the GLA has not allocated any grants or extra funding to Peabody Housing Association during the 2019/20 Covid-19 outbreak. The GLA does not hold information about whether the UK government has provided any grants or extra funding to Peabody Housing Association during the 2019/20 Covid-19 outbreak.
