Thank you for your request for information which the Greater London Authority (GLA) received on 25 June 2021. Your request has been dealt with under the Freedom of Information Act (FOI) 2000.

You asked for:

Details of all the companies that have received funding from The Greater London Authority, in the last year for Offsite/Modular Projects?

Our response to your request is as follows:

Many of the projects we invest in include elements of offsite manufacturing, however, we do not routinely collect that information. Below is a list of companies which have received grant or investment funding from the GLA for projects involving Modern Methods of Construction (MMC) where we have actively collected that information:

- Mount Anvil
- London Borough of Lewisham

We will be collecting more information about MMC used in projects the Mayor is funding.
