Thank you for your request for information which the GLA received on 2 February 2018. Your request has been dealt with under the Environment Information regulations 2004.

You asked for *"a copy of all correspondence between the GLA and the organisation iChoosr in all formats, including but not limited to e-mails"*.

Please find attached the information we have identified as within scope of your request.

Some of the content in the attached is being withheld from disclosure under Regulation 13 (Personal information) of the EIR. This information could potentially identify specific employees and as such constitutes as personal data which is defined by s.1 (1) of the Data Protection Act 1998 to mean data which relates to a living individual who can be identified from that data.

It is considered that disclosure of this information would contravene the first data protection principle which states that "Personal data shall be processed fairly and lawfully and, in particular, shall not be processed unless –

*(a) at least one of the conditions in Schedule 2 is met, and
(b) in the case of sensitive personal data, at least one of the conditions in Schedule 3 is also met."*

It is considered that none of the conditions allow the processing of the information apply in this case as the subjects have not consented to the use of their data for an alternative purpose (namely disclosure under the EIR).
