Thank you for your request for information which the Greater London Authority (GLA) received on 10 March 2021. Your request has been considered under the Freedom of Information Act 2000.

Please find below the information we hold within the scope of your request

Where the '260km of high-quality, safer cycle routes' that have been delivered under Mayor Khan's first term are, in the form of street names, destinations or cycleway designations where appropriate (e.g. CS4, etc.)?

The 260km of cycle routes have been delivered under the Mayor's Healthy Streets Programme as part of the projects listed in Table 1 below. These have been jointly delivered by Transport for London (TfL) and the London boroughs and take the form of Cycleways, Mini Hollands and other Healthy Streets schemes such as town centre improvements, Safer Junctions or Transformational schemes.

Which of these are considered protected routes?

In February 2020, the Mayor announced that he had met his election pledge to triple the amount of protected cycling space in London, going from 50 kilometres in 2016 to 162 kilometres in 2020. Further details are provided here: https://www.london.gov.uk/press-releases/mayoral/mayor-triples-protected-cycle-space-in-london. A breakdown by scheme is included in Table 2 below. (To note, this calculation counts protection in both directions of a street.)

More than 100km of new or upgraded cycle routes have been delivered or are under construction since the start of the pandemic. This comprises a mixture of fully protected routes, semi-segregation and routes on quiet back streets. (To note, this calculation counts routes in just one direction of a street.) This means that the Mayor has delivered 260km of high-quality safe cycle routes during his term.

Because of changes to delivery mechanisms during the pandemic, and because these are temporary schemes, TfL has not tracked the exact lengths of protected space in the same way. Substantial sections of segregation have been built as part of the upgrades to Cycle Superhighways 7 and 8, on Park Lane and Hampstead Road, between Greenwich and Woolwich,

along Cycleway 9, and on a wide number of borough schemes including Green Lanes in Hackney, Uxbridge Road in Ealing, Kew Road in Richmond and Liverpool Road in Islington.

A significant proportion of the 100km of new routes delivered since March 2020 include protection, and many more improvements have been delivered through the hundreds of kms of streets made quieter through low traffic neighbourhood (LTN) schemes. For example, Quietway 2, an existing route, has been much improved through a combination of Islington's Canonbury East and St Peters LTNs, and Hackney's London Fields LTN, and has seen a substantial growth in cycling as a result.

What are the protected routes that the mayor inherited?

The previous administration completed 53km of protected space for cycling (counting routes in both directions), including sections of Cycle Superhighway 3 between Tower Hill and Parliament Square, sections of Cycleway 6 between Elephant and Castle and Blackfriars, the upgraded Cycle Superhighway 2, Cycle Superhighway 5 between Vauxhall and Pimlico, and short sections of protection on Cycle Superhighways 7 and 8, including at Oval.

Which are the junctions that have been made safer referred to in the release?

The 25 Safer Junctions referred to in the press release are set out in Table 3 below.
