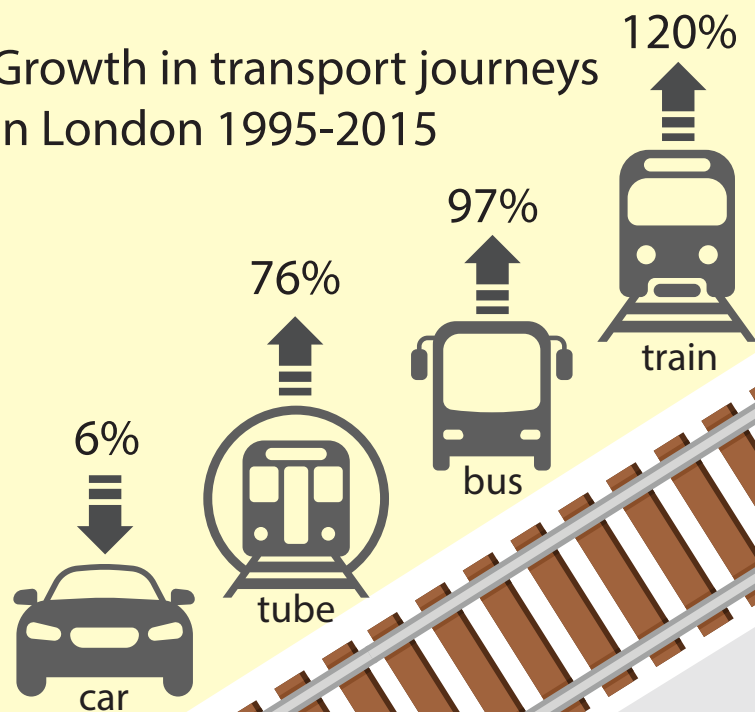


# Transport expenditure in London

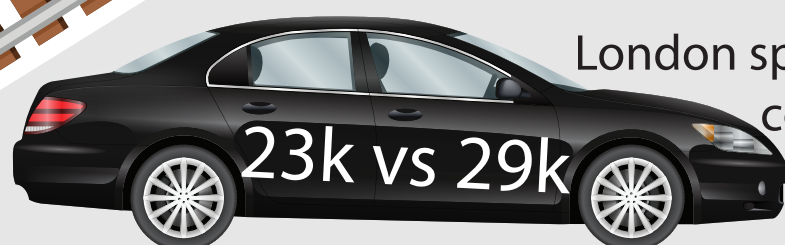
The public sector spent £8.5 billion on transport in London during 2015-16. London received more than a quarter of the UK's expenditure on transport, but this reflects the demand and need for transport in the capital.

Growth in transport journeys in London 1995-2015



London spent £7 per railway passenger journey compared with £10 across Great Britain

London has one of the lowest amounts of railway expenditure and road spending per 'user' in Great Britain



London spent £23k per 1 million vehicle miles compared with £29k across Great Britain

Investing in London is beneficial to the rest of the UK

Goods and services needed to run London's transport network come from across the UK

London is a net contributor to the Exchequer
