Thank you for your request for information about convictions for FGM, which the Greater London Authority (GLA) received via Twitter on 6 February 2018. Your request has been dealt with under the Freedom of Information Act 2000.

You requested:

How many people have been convicted in last 12 months? Figures under the 'freedom of information act' please Mr Mayor

The GLA does not hold the information you have requested. Conviction data is held by the Crown Prosecution Service/HM Courts & Tribunals Service rather than either the GLA or the Metropolitan Police Service (MPS). The Met would be able to provide information about those individuals charged with an offence, yet not the outcome following court.
