Our response:

The GLA does not hold data on patient symptoms. I would recommend getting in touch with Public Health England in the first instance.

A report by PHE on disproportionality of deaths - the <u>COVID-19</u>: review of disparities in risks and outcomes report. This work was led by the PHE Epidemiology and Intelligence teams. It is a descriptive review based on the latest surveillance data available to PHE and from links to wider health data sets. The review looked at different factors including: age and sex; where people live; deprivation; ethnicity; people's occupation; and care home residence. The review showed that there is an association between belonging to some ethnic groups and the likelihood of testing positive and dying with COVID-19.
