A full statistical count, disclosure and description of subsequent action concerning all reports detailing:

(A) Racist hate incidents.

(B) Racist acts of civil discrimination.

(C) Racist hate crimes. (Including murders or attempted murders)

Committed against any black employee by any white employee or any white employee against any black member of the public.

Between Saturday, the 25th of April 2020 through to Saturday, the 25th of July 2020.

After a request by ourselves for clarification, you further requested that this was in relation to:

Complaints regarding those whom directly work with the assembly in accordance to the specifications of the original foir.

Please find below our response to your request:

Between Saturday 25 April 2020 through to Saturday 25 July 2020 there were no reports of any racist hate incidents, racist acts of civil discrimination, or racist hate crimes (Including murders or attempted murders) concerning those whom directly work with the London Assembly committed against any black employee by any white employee or any white employee against any black member of the public.
