Thank you for your request for information which the GLA received on 5<sup>th</sup> April 2018. Your request has been dealt with under Environmental Information Regulations 2004.

You asked for a list of all the sites in London (Zones 1 and 2) that have received planning permission for upward extension but have not been built on yet.

Attached is a list of planning permissions from the London Development Database with the development type of Extension and with a current development status of either not started or under construction.

The Extension code is primarily used for vertical extensions to existing buildings, but is sometimes used for schemes that involve a mix of change of use and extension, and occasionally for lateral extensions to existing dwellings that create a new unit. You may need to scan through the data to get the sub-set that you need.

Information on development starts and completions was last comprehensively updated as at 31/03/2017. While the status of some schemes has been updated since then, others may not have been checked since that date.

A full list of live permissions and completions back to 2006 from the London Development Database can be found on the London Datastore.
