Thank you for your request for information which the GLA received on 23 July 2018. Your request has been dealt with under the Freedom of Information Act 2000.

Our response to your request is as follows:

1. *How much public money the Mayor received to build affordable housing in the year ended March 2018.*

In 2017-18 the Greater London Authority received £694m from government for the provision of affordable homes in contribution to the GLA's affordable homes programmes, including specialised supported housing programmes and funding to replace homes sold through Right to Buy, which are supporting starts of affordable homes through to March 2022.

The annual profile of spend and forecast expenditure is set out draft London Housing Strategy https://www.london.gov.uk/sites/default/files/2018_lhs_london_housing_strategy.pdf.

2. *How many affordable units the Mayor has started in the 2 years since he has been in office.*
