Follow-up request from AECOM to Haringey to check accuracy of information to be included in draft Study. AECOM would have asked Haringey to check for accuracy a) the details of SIL / LSIL in the borough, and b) borough site maps prepared by AECOM.

I also request any correspondence between GLA and AECOM about information supplied by LB Haringey, and Any correspondence between GLA and LB Haringey about the information supplied to AECOM by LB Haringey.

As above correspondence would have included details of sites and maps. Please note that I am only seeking information supplied by LB Haringey

Our response to your request is as follows:

Please find attached the information we hold within scope of your request. LB Haringey updated their local plan in 2017, therefore the Planning team have put together a simple map of the industrial designations as they were in 2015. Please find this attached also along with the GIS files supplied by LB Haringey as part of the correspondence chains.

Please note that employee personal information is exempt from disclosure under s.40 (Personal information) of the Freedom of Information Act. This information could potentially identify specific individuals and as such constitutes as personal data which is defined by Article 4(1) of the General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR) to mean any information relating to an identified or identifiable living individual. Background

The Licensor is licensed by Ordnance Survey under the PSMA Member Licence to use Licensed Data for its Licensed Use. This Standard Form Contractor Licence (Contractor Licence) is entered into pursuant to the PSMA Member Licence and sets out the terms upon which the Licensor sub-licenses Licensed Data to the Contractor to enable the Contractor to provide Works on the Licensor's behalf.

Grant of sub-licence

- 3.1 In consideration of the Contractor providing the Works, the Licensor grants the Contractor, for the Term, a non-exclusive, non-transferrable, revocable sub-licence for Licensed Data, to use the Licensed Data for the Licensor's (and not the Contractor's) Licensed Use solely for the purpose of providing the Works. If, at the Licensor's discretion, it does provide (or provide access to) such Licensed Data, it shall only provide such Licensed Data necessary for the Contractor to provide the Works and shall do so at a time, frequency and on a medium of the Licensor's choosing.
- 5.2 Prior to or upon the Contractor receiving Licensed Data (whether from the Licensor or a Third Party Contractor pursuant to Clause 5.3), the Licensor will Inform the Contractor in writing of the scope of the Licensor's Licensed Use.
- 5.3 The Contractor shall be entitled to supply and receive copies of the Licensed Data in a digital form to and from Third Party Contractors provided that:
- 5.3.1 both the Contractor and the Third Party
 Contractor are licensed by the Licensor
 for the Licensed Data being supplied
 and/or received:
- 5.3.2 the Works and the Third Party Works shall each form part of a larger project or related series of works required by the Licensor;
- 5.3.3 the Contractor uses the copies of the Licensed Data supplied by the Third Party Contractor solely for the purpose of providing the Works to the Licensor as part of the Licensor's Licensed Use;
- 5.3.4 the use by the Contractor of the Licensed Data supplied by the Third Party Contractor shall be governed by this Contractor Licence;
- 5.3.5 the Contractor shall not receive any direct or indirect payment, credit or money's worth for the supply of the Licensed Data to a Third Party Contractor; and

- 5.3.6 the Contractor shall, prior to supplying any Licensed Data to a Third Party Contractor, obtain written confirmation from the Licensor that (a) the Third Party Contractor is licensed by the Licensor for the Licensed Data being supplied, and (b) the Works and the Third Party Works each form part of a larger project or related saries of works required by the Licensor.
- 5.4 The Contractor shall be entitled to supply paper copies of the Licensed Data (to which it has access) (referred to in this Clause as 'Paper Copies') to any third party provided that the Contractor ensures that:
- 5.4.1 such third party is engaged to provide:
- a) all or part of the Works;
- b) part of a larger project (which also includes the Works); or
- works which, together with the Works, are part of a series of works required by the Licensor:
 - and uses the Paper Copies solely for the purpose of providing a) b) or c) above to the Licensor for its Licensed Use;
- 5.4.2 the Paper Copies supplied only cover an area that is proportionate to the amount of the Works that the third party is engaged to provide;
- 5.4.3 such third party is not permitted to and shall not copy, sub-license, distribute, sell or otherwise make available the Paper Coples to third parties in any form;
- 5.4.4 the Contractor recovers or procures the destruction of all such Paper Copies immediately upon (a) completion of the works provided by the third party as referred to in Clause 5.4.1 or (b) expiry or termination of this Contractor Licence, whichever is the sooner, and the Contractor shall provide, at the Licensor's request, a sworn statement by a duly authorised person that it has complied with this Clause;

6 Termination

- 11.2 The Contractor acknowledges that Ordnance Survey shall have no liability whatsoever in respect of its use of the Licensed Data.
- 11.3 Subject to clause 11.1, the Contractor will indemnify the Licensor against all and any loss, liability, costs (including without limitation legal costs), claims, damages or expenses suffered or incurred by the Licensor or for which the Licensor may become liable arising out of any breach by the Contractor of any of the provisions of this Contractor Licence or the use by the Contractor of the Licensed Data.

- 12 Assignment, subcontracting and sublicensing
- 12.1 Except as agreed in writing by
 Ordnance Survey, neither party is
 entitled to assign, license, transfer or
 novate any of their rights and/or
 obligations under this Contractor
 Licence.
- 13 Walver
- 13.1 The walver on a particular occasion by either party of rights under this Contractor Licence does not imply that other rights will be walved.
- 13.2 No delay in exercising any right under this Contractor Licence shall constitute a waiver of such right.
- 14 Contracts (Rights of Third Parties)
 Act 1999
- 14.1 Subject to Clause 14.2, a person who is not a party to this Contractor Licence has no right under the Contracts (Rights of Third Parties) Act 1999 to enforce or enjoy the benefit of any term of this Contractor Licence.
- 14.2 Ordnance Survey shall be entitled to the benefit of the terms of this Contractor Licence and the rights to enforce such terms under the Contracts (Rights of Third Parties) Act 1999.
- 15 Governing Law and Jurisdiction



Dear ALBPO colleagues

Further to GLA updates at recent ALBPO meetings I am writing to let you know how we intend to engage boroughs during the development of the GLA Industrial Land Baseline and Economy Study 2015. This study is being carried out by consultants AECOM/DTZ and it will form part of the evidence base for the next full review of the London Plan and will also be a useful resource for local plan policy development.

The study will update the previous 2010 baseline maps detailing the supply of London's industrial land in designated Strategic Industrial Locations, Locally Significant Industrial Sites and other smaller non-designated industrial sites (including land in waste management, logistics, utilities and land for transport as well as vacant industrial land). The study will also consider industrial land that is potentially changing to other uses, including sites with planning permission for change of use, prior approval office to resi permitted development in industrial areas, local plan site designations, and other potential release for example through Housing Zones and Opportunity Area Planning Frameworks.

AECOM are currently preparing draft 2015 industrial land baseline maps and there will be an opportunity for boroughs to check and verify these maps during the development of the project and confirm details of any local plan proposals for changes to industrial land designations.

We anticipate that the borough verification phase will take place in the second/third week in May, for a period of 2 weeks in total.

Can I thank you in advance for your support with this piece of work and we will be in touch again in May with the draft maps and further details. In the meantime if you have any questions please do not hesitate to get in touch.







There are also outstanding queries about the data from Greenwich, Haringey, Newham and Redbridge, although I don't know the details of these or whether they have responded. Any responses would have gone to my colleague who is currently on leave.

Having reviewed the London Plan SIL and Local Plan GIS boundaries, including with GIS colleagues, we have just a couple of queries relating to them:

- 1. For Bexley and Enfield, a cross-check of the boundaries/layer against the actual borough proposals maps reveals that the LSISs (or equivalent in terms of name/designation) are missing from the 'UDP' dataset. We wanted to confirm whether these have just not been provided by the borough, presumably through error, or whether they had given reason for purposefully not providing them e.g. their draft local plan might be proposing to remove the designation and thus they perhaps didn't want them mapped. If the former, which I'd expect is more likely, we will take the 2010 position on LSIS as the default.
- 2. Are you able to confirm which boroughs didn't respond with GIS files? Whilst we can largely deduce this ourselves by identifying the boroughs with no layers in the dataset, some boroughs, e.g. Kensington and Chelsea, contained little designated land in 2010 and could have since adopted policies whereby none of the land is now designated. If this were the case, there'd be no layers in the dataset for this borough and we would, on the basis of suggested method below (which we are happy with), deduce that the 2010 policy position is correct, when there is a chance it may not be. It would thus be good to head-off this issue by knowing definitively which boroughs responded and those which didn't.

If any of the above is unclear do let me know.

Please find attached two sets of GIS boundaries.
The first set "New SILs March 2015" contains the London Plan SILs based upon the boundaries taken from borough adopted local plans. We didn't receive GIS files from a few boroughs and so we have digitised these ourselves based upon the adopted borough proposals maps on line. Please use this layer as the basis for the <u>current 2015 adopted SIL boundaries</u> for our study.
The second set "Adopted UDP Industrial Land Mar2015" contains adopted Local Plan GIS boundaries for employment and industrial related sites/locations. This will help with defining the <u>current 2015 adopted locally significant industrial/waste/employment site</u> boundaries. Note that we have not stripped out purely 'office' or specifically 'non-industrial' layers — so before applying this layer you may need to strip these out first. You may also have to strip out the SILs from this layer so we don't accidently duplicate the layers with the "New SILs March 2015" layer above. As noted above we are missing GIS layers for a few boroughs and these will be clear when you open the files. As a default position on these 'missing' boroughs I suggest you use the 2010 layers for locally significant industrial/waste/employment sites <u>outside</u> the SILs (for the SILs we have digitised these ourselves as noted above).


