Thank you for your request for information which the GLA received on 3 October. Your request has been dealt with under the Freedom of Information Act 2000. You asked for:

Any census data or any other data on the previous tenants of Drummond Crescent, Fuston.

We can confirm that the GLA does not hold the information you have requested.

Census returns remain confidential for 100 years, so censuses up to 1911 only are currently in the public domain. Some local authorities hold microfilm copies of census returns for their area, but the Greater London Authority does not.
