Freedom of Information Request – Garden Bridge

Thank you for your request for information which the GLA received on 12 September 2017. Your request has been dealt with under the Freedom of Information Act 2000.

You asked for:

- *Total amount spent relating to procurement of materials or parts for the Garden Bridge;*
- *A breakdown of this spending by whether orders were completed/delivered.*

The Garden Bridge Trust is an independent charity that was set up under the previous Mayor to fundraise for and deliver the Garden Bridge. The Garden Bridge Trust is responsible for the money spent on the project.
