Thank you for your request for information which the GLA received on 2 December 2019. Your request has been dealt with under the Freedom of Information Act 2000.

You asked for: *the data sets of all the drinking fountains in London.*

Our response to your request is as follows:

The GLA does not hold the data sets of all drinking fountains in London.

However, the Mayor of London has partnered with Thames Water to install over 100 drinking fountains across the city. So far 26 fountains have been made operational. The Mayor also installed 28 drinking fountains with the Zoological Society of London #OneLess Campaign.

All 44 drinking fountains are mapped on Refill London's website here <https://refill.org.uk/refill-london/> along with more than 3,500 refill points across the capital.

These programmes are part of a range of measures the Mayor of London is taking to improve public access to free drinking water and help cut single-use plastics in the capital.
