Our response to your request is as follows:

Q1. The final cost of the Isle of Dogs & South Poplar Opportunity Area Planning Framework process i.e. what did it cost to produce the final OAPF i.e. the documents attached to this link

A1. It is not possible to provide a figure for internal costs, as the GLA Growth Strategies and Urban Design team don't record their time on specific projects.

However, the following costs were incurred by use of external consultants:

- i. Dedicated urban design support to produce the Isle of Dogs Opportunity Area Planning Framework 2015-2016

Total cost: £50,000

- ii. Peter Brett Associates were commissioned to produce an Integrated Impact Assessment (IIA) including:
- Strategic Environmental Assessment (SEA)
 - Sustainability Appraisal (SA)
 - Habitats Regulations Assessment (HRA)
 - Health Impact Assessment (HIA)
 - Equalities Impact Assessment (EqIA)
 - Community Safety Impact Assessment (CSIA)

Total cost: - £20,956

- iii. Peter Brett Associates were commissioned to produce Development Infrastructure Funding (DIF) Study (2016)

Total Cost: £133,168

Q.2 I believe some costs were also incurred by TfL, do I need to FOI those separately?

A.2 Yes. A separate Freedom of Information request would be required to obtain TfL costs as regulations consider the GLA and TfL as separate organisations.


Q.3 Can you also confirm monies received from Canary Wharf Group and One Housing Group who helped fund this?

- Canary Wharf Group contributed £50,000 towards the production of the Isle of Dogs OAPF in 2015.
- One Housing Group contributed £25,000 towards the production of the Isle of Dogs OAPF in 2015.
