Please find attached the information which the GLA holds within scope of your request. The information is for London and drawn from the CHAIN database. In many cases there is support for people where required on arrival to the new settled base. For Mayoral services, people must agree to the reconnection and appropriate, sustainable accommodation must be available in the destination.
