**MAYORAL DELEGATION AND DIRECTION TO TRANSPORT FOR LONDON –
INVICTUS GAMES 2014**

Delegation

Under section 38(1) of the Greater London Authority Act 1999 ("GLAA") I, BORIS JOHNSON, MAYOR OF LONDON, hereby delegate to Transport for London (TfL) for the purposes of furthering social development in Greater London, the exercise of the Mayor's powers in section 30 of the GLAA to empower and enable TfL to provide, free of charge, 1,000 "pay as you go" Oyster cards for use by carers, families and friends of the athletes who will be participating in the 2014 Invictus Games.

Direction

In accordance with section 155(1) (c) of the GLAA and in pursuance of my duty under section 174 of the GLAA, I hereby direct TfL to exercise the power hereby delegated to it and to provide 1,000 "Pay as you go" Oyster cards free of charge for use by carers, families and friends of the athletes who will be participating in the 2014 Invictus Games.
