Good morning MOPAC Information Team,

I hope this email finds you well. Our research team at the London School of Economics is currently conducting research on business trends in London, specifically looking at the annual/monthly incorporation count of companies.

I have an older data set (April 2008 - July 2017) on Police Strength by Role, Borough and Business Unit that was supplied by MOPAC and uploaded to the London Datastore by the GLA Intelligence Unit. The document was titled (MASTER_mps-figures_new) and appears to have originally been created/uploaded by a Mr. Richard Fairchild.

I am interested in obtaining additional Workforce Strength data from July 2017 through the present by role and at the borough level. I see that that your workforce dashboard (<https://www.london.gov.uk/what-we-do/mayors-office-policing-and-crime-mopac/data-and-statistics/policing/workforce-dashboard>) has this data available, but I would have to download it a month at a time for each borough. And, the data available on the London Datastore unfortunately only is available at the GLA level (<https://data.london.gov.uk/dataset/police-force-strength>).

May I please request a .csv document of the data behind your Tableau generated Workforce dashboard of borough level Officer/Sergeant/Special/PSCO/Staff strength from July 2017 through Jun 2019?
