Thank you for your clarified request for information which the Greater London Authority (GLA) received on 10 September 2020. Your request has been considered under the Freedom of Information Act 2000.

You requested:

*Founded on the Freedom of Information Act of 2000 (Fol), I request the GLA, the following:  
Inform me what has been the highest sanction imposed by the body? To whom? and by what concept?*

And you clarified:

*In reference to the information request number MGLA061020-6351, in which I am asked to clarify the required information, in this regard I indicate the following:*

- Sanctions, I mean punishments for public officials for not complying with or respecting the Freedom of Information Act of 2000 (Fol).*
- In this regard, I indicate the types of sanctions: Acting with negligence, fraud or bad faith during the substantiation of requests regarding access to information or, by not disseminating the information related to the transparency obligations provided for in the Freedom Law of Information 2000 (Fol).*

*I require you to inform me of the above, what has been the highest sanction imposed by the internal control body or the competent authority of the GLA? To which public official? and by what concept?*

Our response to your request is below:

The Information Commissioner's Office (ICO) is the UK's independent regulator and has a number of roles and responsibilities for complying with the Freedom of Information Act and UK Data Protection legislation, including imposing penalties where appropriate.

1. There have been no ICO Enforcement Actions against the GLA.
