• Brewsters Waste Management

The Brewsters Waste Management claim is still outstanding. We are likely to conclude the claim around July 2018.

Clearun

A claim for compensation was made against the GLA. The claim failed at first instance and an appeal was brought in the Court of Appeal. The outcome was that the appeal was stayed on confidential terms agreed by the parties. Please find attached a copy of the Consent Order.

McFen Haulage

The claim for compensation against the GLA was settled in early 2016. Please find attached a copy of the Consent Order.
