- 2. If the answer is yes can you please provide copies of this correspondence and communication.*
- 3. During the aforementioned period did The Mayor reply to this correspondence and communication or did he write to Ms Lumley about The Garden Bridge.*
- 4. If the answer to question three is yes can you please provide copies of this correspondence and communication including emails.*
- 5. If any documentation has been destroyed can you please provide the following information. In the case of each destroyed piece of documentation can you state when it was destroyed and why. In the case of each destroyed piece of documentation can you please provide a brief outline of its contents. In the case of each destroyed piece of correspondence and communication can you provide details of the sender, the recipient and the date generated. Can you also provide a brief outline of its contents. In the case of ALL destroyed documentation if the documentation continues to be held in another form can you please provide a copy of that document.*
