Thank you for your request for information which the Greater London Authority (GLA) received on 6th February 2020. Your request has been dealt with under the Freedom of information Act 2000.

You asked for:

Please can you provide affordable housing grants given across the GLA since its inception of the mayor's office in 2000. If you are unable to do so, please provide grant data in same breakdown format as above FOI request reference dating as far back as the Affordable Homes Policy. for all affordable housing grants given across the GLA.

Please note that prior to 2012, the responsibility for housing investment was with Homes and Communities Agency (HCA). On 1 April 2012, this function was devolved to the Greater London Authority under the Localism Act 2011.

Since devolution, the Mayor of London has developed strategies and provided investment to deliver homes under various programmes, including:

- Mayor's Housing Covenant: Homes for Working Londoners –September 2012
- Mayor's Housing Covenant: Building the Pipeline – March 2013
- Mayor's Housing Covenant: 2015-18 Programme –December 2013
- Mayor's Housing Covenant: Homelessness Change and Platform for Life – March 2015
- Building Council Homes for Londoners – May 2018
- Homes for Londoners 2016-21 – November 2016
- Addendum to the Homes for Londoners 2016-21 Programme – June 2018.
- Homes for Londoners 2016-21 – November 2016
