CRL Transparency

Please accept my apologies for the late hour of this email but I wanted to get in touch with you directly in advance of the Assembly's Transport Committee hearing tomorrow.

It strikes me that in light of the recent announcement, there is going to be a lot of interest in the proceedings of the Crossrail Board over the last few months.

I know that there are already some FOI requests on this and there are likely to be other requests for access to the minutes. I also know that CRL and TfL are discussing the appropriate extent of publication.

My own view is that the minutes should be disclosed as soon as possible with the minimum of redactions, only where it is essential to avoid harm to ongoing commercial negotiations and where there is otherwise a very clear justification for redactions.

Ideally, I would have spoken to you directly about this but I did not want to wait until tomorrow and felt it appropriate to mention now in case this matter arises in questioning at the committee.

I hope you will agree that is the right approach.
