Thank you for your request for information which the GLA received on 7 May 2019. Your request has been dealt with under the Freedom of Information Act 2000.

Our response to your request is as follows:

- 1. Your question asked for access to “the list of applications for shared ownership received in the localities listed below, specifically the number of households registered for Shared Ownership.”*

The GLA has access to data on the following:

- the number of enquiries individuals have made in relation to Shared Ownership properties advertised on the Mayor’s Homes for Londoners property portal; and
- the number of individuals who have registered their interest for Shared Ownership properties advertised on the Mayor’s Homes for Londoners property portal.

We do not collate the above information on a household level. Therefore, this data is only available for individual users of the property portal.

Our partners, Full Communications, who manage the property portal for us, have provided data in relation to the number of individuals who have enquired about and/or have registered their interest for Shared Ownership properties advertised on the property portal. This data is set out in the table below and covers the period from 4 April 2018, when the website went live, to 21 May 2019.
