I refer to your letter received on 5 February 2016 consulting the Mayor of London on the above planning application, which is referable under Category 3D of the Schedule to the Order 2008. I have assessed the details of the application for creation of Burial Ground with ancillary buildings, parking and landscaping. It is noted that this application is a repeat submission of the previous application assessed in January 2015 (LPA application ref: P1512.14), which the Mayor has supported (GLA ref: D&P3558).
