You requested:

I understand that the GLA has given authorisation for the use of Parliament Square Gardens (PSG) on September 1st for a "Make London Safe Again" rally. The rally will include an inflatable blimp/balloon cartooning the London Mayor Sadiq Khan.

In accordance with the Freedom of Information (FOI) Act 2000, I would like to ask you for the following information.

- 1. A copy of the application by Yanny Bruere to use PSG for this purpose.
- 2. Any correspondence from the GLA advising the applicant of the restrictions associated to timing for the event, use of stages, public address systems, live music, sale of goods and distribution of food and drink.
- 3. A copy of the letter providing authorisation for the event.

Please find attached the information we hold within the scope of your request.

Please note that some personal data has been redacted. The names of members of staff are exempt from disclosure under s.40 (Personal information) of the Freedom of Information Act. This information could potentially identify specific employees and as such constitutes as personal data which is defined by Article 4(1) of the General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR) to mean any information relating to an identified or identifiable living individual.
