Our response to your request is as follows:

The amount of money spent on official photography and videography services by the Greater London Authority in each year since 2016.

Please find below the information we hold within the scope of your request.

- Photography and videography cost for 2016/17 - £171,295.35
- Photography and videography cost for 2017/18 - £123,208.05
- Photography and videography cost for 2018/19 - £209,242.70

Additionally, the GLA pays for the services of an onsite broadcasting unit. They broadcast all Mayoral and Assembly meetings within the building, which are available for public viewing on our website. They also assist with all audio visual set ups for events within the main event areas of the building. Outlined below are their costs:

- Broadcasting cost for 2016/17 - £357,984.52
- Broadcasting cost for 2017/18 - £373,600.73
- Broadcasting cost for 2018/19 - £534,407.82
