Thank you for your request for information which the GLA received on 2 October 2018. Your request has been dealt with under the Freedom of Information Act 2000.

You asked for:

- *Number of Chinese residents (ethnicity) in each borough*
- *Number older Chinese (65+) in each borough*
- *Number of Chinese overseas students studying for high education in these boroughs*

Please find attached data that provides 2018 figures for the number of Chinese residents (ethnicity) in each borough and also the equivalent figures for just people aged 65 and over. This data is sourced from the GLA's 2016-based ethnic population projections.
