Two vehicles

Vehicle 1

GLA Land and Property Ltd (GLAP) inherited a Land Rover Defender 110 County from the Homes and Communities Agency (HCA) when the HCA's functions in London transferred to the GLA following the Localism Act 2011. It is used by GLA Land and Property Ltd (GLAP) agents to visit and inspect sites across the Authority's portfolio. This vehicle runs on diesel and has been converted so that it is compliant with the Low Emission Zone requirement.

Vehicle 2

The second is not in use currently and is in storage. This vehicle was gifted to the GLAP. GLAP are the legal owner. It is a Towrite 440 and is an electric vehicle
