Thank you for your request for information which the Greater London Authority (GLA) received on 16 October 2020. Your request has been considered under the Freedom of Information Act 2000.

You requested:

- a) Details of all public gatherings on 11 October 2020 at Marble Arch on the A4202 in central London.*
- b) All correspondence between the Mayor or his office and the police regarding granting permission for public gatherings/demonstrations on 11 October 2020 in the Marble Arch area.*
- c) Any estimates of the number of people gathering at Marble Arch on 11 October 2020 and reports on the impact on traffic on the A4202.*

Our response to your request is below:

- a) The GLA has not located information in scope of your request.
- b) I can confirm that the GLA did not receive a request for permission for gatherings in the Marble Arch area on 11 October 2020. The GLA is not the landlord for Marble Arch or the surrounding area and would have no involvement in the granting of permissions for any such demonstrations.
- c) The GLA does not hold estimates of the number of people in the Marble Arch area on 11 October, or on the impact on traffic.
