The current London Plan (2016) requires development proposals to minimise carbon emissions and sets out the required improvement over building regulations for residential and non-domestic development in Policy 5.2

The draft London Plan (<u>version showing minor suggested changes 2018</u>) sets out a zero carbon target for major development which includes energy efficiency improvements over building regulations and minimum on-site carbon reduction requirements coupled with carbon offsetting for remaining emissions. Further detail is set out in Policy SI2.
