Freedom of Information Act request

In response to your recent request for information. Your request has been dealt with under the Freedom of Information Act 2000 and we can today provide you with a response to your request. I am sorry for the delay in responding and hope that this has not inconvenienced you.

Your request asked for the release of the following information:

1. Please could you share the physical number and financial value of the single use plastic water bottles sold at the London Kitchen cafe for the last 3 financial years.

The number of single use, 500ml water bottles sold in London's Kitchen café at City Hall is as follows:

Financial Year	No. of Bottles	Value
2014/15	7776	£8,709.12
2015/16	7536	£8,892.48
2016/17	8256	£10,320.00
2017 to 7/12/17	7104	£8,880.00

In addition to bottled water to take away, City Hall also offers free of charge tap water from dispensers in the café and a water fountain. This year, City will also be phasing out the sale of single-use plastic water bottles.
