Thank you for your request for information which the Greater London Authority (GLA) received on 19 April 2022. Your request has been considered under the Environment Information Regulations (EIR) 2004.

You requested:

Fiona Fletcher-Smith is now CEO for London and Quadrant. Her past position raises major concerns. Fiona was Executive Director for Development, Enterprise, and Environment at the Greater London Authority (GLA).

As part of the senior management team for the GLA, Fiona was responsible for overseeing the delivery and implementation of key strategies such as the London Plan, the Economic Development Strategy, transport, environment and climate change and in overseeing the operation of the Mayor's powers in relation to significant planning applications in the capital.

Under Freedom of Information can I request a list of all projects Fiona worked on. Including planning applications that were approved.

Please find below the information we hold within the scope of your request.

The GLA has robust policies and procedures in place to record interests and manage any conflicts. Our Staff Code of Ethics underpins our approach, with specific requirements including the need for senior staff to maintain a standing register of interests, for interests to be declared and managed as part of procurement processes and for any interests to be declared in decision forms (our mechanism for taking significant decisions).
