Thank you for your request for information which the GLA received on 22<sup>nd</sup> November 2020. Your request has been dealt with under the Freedom of Information Act 2000.

You asked:

*Please can I request the number of deaths from 1st January 2020 – 20th November 2020 (inclusive) in each of the following accommodation types commissioned by your authority:*

- accommodation for homeless people, including hostels and supported accommodation for people identified as rough sleeping or with a history of rough sleeping*
- temporary accommodation commissioned by the local authority*
- supported accommodation for homeless young people*

*Please can this include the cause of death or suspected cause of death, date of death, and the person's age when they died.*

Our response to your request is as follows:

The GLA does not hold this information, except for where we receive an incident report for people supported by the Mayor's services (see below). The GLA does not fund hostels, very limited amounts of supported accommodation, temporary accommodation, or supported accommodation specifically for young people.
