Thank you for your request for information which the Greater London Authority (GLA) received on 14 June 2021. Your request has been dealt with under the Freedom of Information Act 2000.

You asked for:

I have provided proof to TfL regarding serious ethical wall violations by Installation Technology (ITECH) in the tendering process for the Transport for London Telecommunications Commercialisation Project (TfL TCP). ITECH are partnering with BAI on this multi-billion pound bid. I have in my possession two recorded conversations which conclusively prove this corruption. TfL have completed their investigation into this proven corruption and have taken no punitive steps against ITECH. In fact, they have rewarded them with millions of pounds of new business. TfL appear to be complicit in this corruption and seem to be actively protecting ITECH and BAI.

Is the Mayor of London aware of this corruption?

What action is the Mayor's office taking to stamp out this corruption?

Our response to your request is as follows:

Towards the end of the extensive tender process, accusations of alleged ethical wall breaches were made in relation to one of the tenderers. TfL takes any accusations of corruption very seriously and these allegations have been investigated and, where appropriate, action has been taken.
