Thank you for your request for information which the GLA received on 13<sup>th</sup> November 2017. Your request has been dealt with under the Freedom of Information Act 2000.

**You asked:**

*Thank you for your response, I understand the reasons for your refusal and found the advice you provided very helpful particularly the following extract. 'In order to bring your request within the cost threshold, you may wish to limit it by focussing on the grant funding agreements related to the MRF investment in Tottenham'.*

*I therefore wish to follow that advice and thus request the following as it relates to the MRF investment in Tottenham. On 16th January 2012, the Mayor of London announced a 41,345,000 funding and investment package for Tottenham. Haringey council reported in February 2012 that this included a total of 28m in GLA grants. Please supply a copy of the grant funding application and agreements relating to this. I understand as explained in your letter that this will be treated as a new FOI for timescales and look forward to your response in due course.*

**Our response to your request is as follows:**

**1. Requesting a “copy of grant funding applications”**

The Mayor's Regeneration Fund (MRF) was not administered by a formal bidding round. The most riot affected Boroughs were invited to propose ideas for investment that could underpin immediate economic bounce-back, longer term economic uplift and growth and associated skills development and employability programmes to ensure local people could access the benefits of said growth. These proposals were developed over a period of months in conversation with the GLA and first expressed as GLA Investment Programme Board papers and ultimately the Mayoral Decision papers you have been directed to in our previous response.

**2. Requesting a copy of “agreements”**

Haringey proceeded with seven projects under the MRF. They are as follows:

1. 639 Enterprise Centre
2. Controlled Parking Zone
3. Growth on the High Road
4. Haringey Accessibility
5. Haringey Employment Support
6. Haringey Opportunity Investment Fund
7. Station Approach

The agreements for each of these projects have been attached.
