Please would you let me know in writing if you hold information of the following description:

Information concerning the practical application by

the Mayor, and

the Mayor's Office for Policing & Crime

of the definition of Islamophobia as defined by the All-Party Parliamentary Group on British Muslims.

For example,

guidelines on how they apply the definition,

any complaints of Islamophobia or alleged Islamophobia which have been received and how they have been handled.

To include, correspondence between the Mayor and the Home Office on the subject of security at mosques.
