Thank you for your request for information which the GLA received on 22 February 2021. Your request has been dealt with under the Freedom of Information Act 2000.

You asked for;

- *In December 2020, a statement¹ from the Mayor of London stated: "Newham Council has granted planning permission for the necessary modifications needed at The Crystal, including the creation of a new chamber." What are the costs of these modifications, according to the latest estimates? Please break them down into categories.*
- *It has been reported that some GLA staff will relocate to the London Fire Brigade's headquarters in Union Street, Southward. What are the costs of the modifications of the LFB's headquarters required to accommodate this. Please break them down into categories.*

Our response to your request is as follows:

We have published MD2705² (Relocation of City Hall to the Royal Docks) which includes supporting documents outlining the one-off costs of relocation broken down by category (Please see Annex 8, Page 84). These costs are inclusive for both the Crystal and Union Street.
