Thank you for your request for information which the Greater London Authority (GLA) received on 29 September 2020. Your request has been dealt with under the Freedom of Information Act 2000

You asked for:

In relation to this Strategic Partnership Agreement with Peabody, which you released under an FOI request in June 2018. Please confirm:

- *Is that version of the Strategic Partnership Agreement still valid, or has it been amended? If it has been amended, please publish a copy of the amended agreement.*
- *When is the SPA due to finish? (Including any agreed extensions).*
- *How many homes have been delivered under it?*

Our response to your request is as follows:

I can confirm that the agreement referred to in the link¹ is still valid. It is still the current Approved Provider contract for Peabody for the 2016-21 programme.

The Ministry of Housing, Communities & Local Government has now extended the starts deadline for this programme to 2023 so in approved circumstances, starts can now occur up to March 2023. Peabody have started 3,707 starts under this contract to date.
