Thank you for your request for information which the GLA received on 2 March 2019. Your request has been dealt with under the Freedom of Information Act (2000).

You requested details of how many trees the GLA has funded over the last four years (broken down by borough) and how many it intends to fund over the next two years.

Our response to your request is as follows:

Please find attached a table outlining the number of trees funded by the GLA over the last four years. This information is provided for each financial year from 2015-16 to 2018-19 and broken down by borough.

In total 202,264 trees have been funded by the GLA during this period. This includes trees planted through Mayoral tree planting programmes and grant schemes, and directly through GLA regeneration and housing schemes. It does not include trees planted by Transport for London, nor do these figures represent all tree planting in London. We do not hold data related to the number of trees planted by local authorities with their own funding, or trees planted by individual home owners, other public bodies, developers or businesses.

Over the next two years the Mayor will award additional grant funding through his Greener City Fund to support more tree planting. We are unable to provide details on the specific number of trees that will be planted as this will be dependent on the grant applications received.
