Thank you for your request for information which the Greater London Authority (GLA) received on 31 August 2018. Your request has been dealt with under the Freedom of Information Act 2000.

You requested:

I would like to know who was offered funding in the last round of the Young Londoners Fund

Applications for round one of the Young Londoners Fund closed on 9 July 2018. We have published details of the projects that have been offered funding from the Young Londoners Fund on the Young Londoners Fund section of our website www.london.gov.uk/young-londoners-fund. This includes information on the Young Londoners Fund and Sport Unites projects that have been awarded a small grant. Small grants are allocations of up to £90,000 over the three-year delivery period.

We are planning to let applicants for medium and large Young Londoners Fund grants know if they have been provisionally awarded funding (pending due diligence checks) in the middle of October. Information on who has been awarded a medium or large grant will be published on www.london.gov.uk/young-londoners-fund once the due diligence checks have been completed.
