

Please find below the information we hold within the scope of your request:

I would refer you to our latest published accounts, where from page 130 you can find sections called *Transactions with subsidiaries* and *Interests in other organisations*, which give information about the various relationships, noting that the model is not the same in each case. We also publish our decisions and a log of grants awarded by the GLA. Not all the organisations listed are private entities, and not all the grants and contracts will fall within the definition of the request but I hope this allows you to identify the information of interest for your research.
