Thank you for your request for information which the GLA received on 19 October 2017. Your request has been dealt with under the Freedom of Information Act 2000.

You requested:

- *please provide, for each report in the last five years (broken down by committee), the number of recommendations that were listed for the Mayor of London to consider*
- *please provide, for each report in the last five years (broken down by committee), the number of recommendations that the Mayor of London has explicitly acknowledged, accepted and adopted following the publication of the report.*

The London Assembly's Committees publish their recommendations and any responses to recommendations on the publications page for each of their investigations. They are recorded at <https://www.london.gov.uk/about-us/london-assembly/london-assembly-publications?order=DESC>. For example, the Mayor's response to the Housing Committee's report At Home with Nature, can be found at the bottom of that publication's web page: <https://www.london.gov.uk/about-us/london-assembly/london-assembly-publications/home-nature>.

Please note that most London Assembly reports result in a Mayoral response but not all. Where publications coincide with a Mayoral election or where recommendations are aimed at other bodies, a Mayoral response may not be issued. Often other functional bodies, for example, Transport for London, will respond to the reports. And in some instances, for example, those on air quality, recommendations can take years to be acted on. For these reasons we do not collate information on the number of recommendations that the Mayor of London has explicitly acknowledged, accepted and adopted.
