Thank you for your request for information which the Greater London Authority (GLA) received on 8 December 2021. Your request has been considered under the Freedom of Information Act 2000.

You requested:

We would like to request a full list of estate regeneration ballots and their results which have taken place in London since July 2018.

We have only been able to find listings for successful votes, but require the data for unsuccessful and abandoned applications also.

Our response to your request is as follows:

We (the GLA) will not necessarily be aware of any ballots in which residents have voted against plans, because IPs are only required to inform us about a ballot at the point when they are demonstrating that one has been carried out in line with the requirements set out in the CFG and with a positive result for the purpose of securing grant (as per 8.5.19 of the CFG), but that we do publish and regularly update a list of positive ballots at [Estate Regeneration - Data | London City Hall](#)
